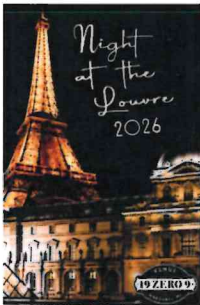


# Fountain Clinic Spring Newsletter 2026
